

SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME (SSI) ELIGIBILITY STATUS**I-2100****I-2100** General Information**

The following requirements apply to SSI and Extended Medicaid programs:

- SSI Eligibility,
- loss of SSI/MSS, and
- eligibility for and receipt of SSI/RSDI.

Application for SSI is not a requirement for Medicaid. Advise the applicant/recipient who meets SSI eligibility requirements that they may be eligible for cash benefits and suggest they contact SSA.

When MEDT approves disability and SSI is denied, Medicaid may be continued only if:

- the SSI denial is appealed,
- the recipient follows through with the appeal, and
- the applicant/recipient provides medical information which indicates a deterioration of the condition.

Resubmit Form MEDT to MEDT and indicate the date of the SSI denial.

I-2110 SSI ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

The individual must be eligible for and receiving SSI as determined by SSA.

I-2110.1 Verification

Verify SSI eligibility and receipt at application or if otherwise indicated. Written verification is required.

Sources include, but are not limited to:

- SSX,
- SSA award letter,
- SSA records, correspondence or forms, or
- third party query.

I-2110.2 Documentation

Document **verification** and file a copy of the proof in the **electronic** case record (**ECR**).

I-2120 LOSS OF SSI OR MSS REQUIREMENT

The individual must have:

- once been eligible for and receiving SSI or MSS, and
- lost of eligibility for SSI or MSS.

I-2120.1 Verification

Verify eligibility for and loss of SSI or MSS at application, **renewal** or if otherwise indicated, using sources in the following order:

- case record documentation (BENDEX, third party query, or **MEDS** files), or
- SSA records, correspondence, or forms.

I-2120.2 Documentation

Document verification and file a copy of the proof in the **electronic** case record (**ECR**).
